ABA uses positive reinforcement and individualized teaching to support growth in areas like communication, social skills, independence, and behavior regulation. ABA can help children reach their fullest potential at home, in school, and in the community.

Benefits of ABA:

- Teaches communication, social, and daily living skills
- Reduces behaviors that interfere with learning
- Encourages independence for your child's unique needs
- Involves and supports parents every step of the way

What can ABA help with?

- Improving communication skills (verbal, nonverbal, and alternative methods like Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC))
